WHY IT MATTERS?



• Monthly Moonsighting is Fardh Kifāyah - A communal obligation in Islam

إن ترائي الهلال في جميع شهور السنة واجب كفائي، لأنه مما لا يتم الواجب إلا به، يؤيد ذلك: فعله صلي الله عليه وسلم وتقريره “the sighting of the hilāl in all months of the year is a communal obligation, because it is one of the things without which a wājib cannot be fulfilled. This is supported by the actions of Rasulullah ﷺ”

- Resolution of the Islamic Fiqh Academy, Jeddah 1433 AH/2012 CE

- Ensures accuracy in Islamic dates and ‘Ibadāt like Ramadan, Eid al-Fitr, and Eid al-Adha
- Preserves Islamic identity and heritage
